Installation Instructions

Inspection of Shipment:

Unpack all cartons and check thoroughly for any damage that may have occurred during transit. Damage claims should be filed immediately with the transportation company. Gold Medal Products is not responsible for damage that occurs in transit.

Setup:

Your Reddy Apple Cooker was assembled and tested at the factory. Remove all packing material and tape before starting operation.

Electrical Requirements:

The following power supply must be provided:

Model # 4008: 120 Volt, 60 Cycle, 1515 Watts, 12.5 Amps Model # 4016: 120 Volt, 60 Cycle, 1800 Watts, 15 Amps Model # 4008 EX: 230 Volt, 50 Cycle, 1500 Watts, 6.5 Amps Model # 4016 EX: 230 Volt, 50 Cycle, 1800 Watts, 7.8 amps



A DANGER

Machine must be properly grounded to prevent shock in case of electrical problems.

Wall receptacle must be wired as shown on the receptacle. Failure to wire properly will void the warranty and can result in damage to motors, elements, relay, lights, etc.

Your electrician must furnish sufficient power for proper machine operation. We recommend this Cooker be on a dedicated and circuit protected line. Failure to wire properly will void the warranty and may result in damage to the machine.

It is Gold Medal Products Company's recommendation that this machine be plugged directly into a wall outlet. The use of extension cords is not recommended due to safety concerns, and may cause sacrificed and/or reduced performance.

Before You Plug In Machine:

- 1. Make sure the wall outlet can accept the grounded plugs (where applicable) on the power supply cord.
- 2. The wall outlet must have the proper polarity. If in doubt, have a competent electrician inspect the outlet and correct if necessary.
- 3. **DO NOT** use a grounded to un-grounded receptacle adapter.

Cooking Instructions

Model #4008:



Be careful, apple solution is extremely hot and can cause severe burns.

- 1. Plug the unit into an appropriate 120 (or 230 for export) Volt outlet.
- Mix one package of Gold Medal Reddy Apple Mix (Catalog #4146) and 6 ounces of water into the Reddy Apple Cooker pot. Stir the mix until it is completely saturated with water.
- 3. Turn the knob clockwise to the setting marked "HIGH". The knob should fall into position when engaged.
- 4. Insert a Gold Medal Thermometer (Catalog #4300) into the mixture.
- 5. Stir the mixture occasionally until the mix begins to boil rapidly. Once the candy boils rapidly, no further mixing will be necessary. Now you can begin to prepare your apples using Gold Medal candy apple sticks by inserting them into the top of the apples. –Item #4006 Setter Sticker may be desired for this process.

NOTE: Apples must be dry and room temperature for candy to stick properly. - Item #4165 Apple Prep can be used to remove the wax/shellac from the apples.

- 6. After 20 minutes, the candy mixture should reach 290°F. Turn the unit "OFF" once this temperature has been attained.
- 7. Holding the prepared apples by the stick, dip them into candy mixture, twisting until completely covered. Place the coated apples onto a clean flat surface. Do not let apples touch one another or they will stick together. Once you are finished dipping your apples, while using pot holders, pour the remainder of the mix onto a flat cookie sheet so it can harden and be broken into pieces.
- 8. Using oven mitts or pot holders return the Reddy Apple Cooker pot into the well.
- 9. **To Clean:** Pour approximately 2 cups of water in the Reddy Apple Cooker pot. Cover the pot with the Steam-n-clean lid and turn the unit to "HI". Allow the water to boil so the steam will clean the inside of the pot.
- 10. Turn the unit "OFF", and let the water cool for 1 hour. Finally, using oven mitts or pot holders empty the pot.

Model #4016:

- 1. Plug the unit into an appropriate 120 (or 230 for export) Volt outlet.
- 2. Mix two packages of Gold Medal Reddy Apple Mix (Catalog #4146) and 12 ounces of water into the Reddy apple cooker pot. Stir the mix until it is completely saturated with water. Or use Gold Medal's APPL–EZ, following the instructions on the bag.
- 3. Turn the knob clockwise to the setting marked "HIGH". The knob should fall into Position when engaged.
- 4. Insert a Gold Medal Thermometer (Catalog #4300) into the mixture.
- 5. Stir the mixture occasionally until the mix begins to boil rapidly. Once the candy boils rapidly, no further mixing will be necessary. Now you can begin to prepare apples using Gold Medal candy apple sticks, by inserting the sticks into the top of the apples. Item #4006 Setter Sticker may be desired for this process.


Parts - Apple Cooker Pot




Parts - Apple Cooker Pot (cont.)
